



1. Concise adjectives / -able adjectives

Various meanings of V-able

- a. V-<u>able</u> = can be V-ed (V할 <u>수있는</u>, V가 <u>가능한</u>, V할 만한)
 - Cancer is **curable:** cure-able = cure할 수있다 / cure가 가능하다
 - = Cancer can be cured. / Cancer is possible to cure.
 - Your story is **believable:** believe-able = 믿을 수있다 / 믿을 만하다 = Your story **can be believed**.
- b. V-able = can be **easily** V-ed (**쉽게** V할 수있는)
- c. V-able = must be V-ed (V해야 하는, V해 마땅한)
- d. V-able = can V (V할 수있는)
 - This food is **perishable**: perish-able = 상할 수 있다
 - = This food can perish.

V-able = 수동형

V-able = 능동형

1. Concise adjectives / -able adjectives


Negations

- un-: unbelievable, unforeseeable, unjustifiable, unreliable, unreadable, unbreakable, unmovable unchangeable, unpayable, unrenewable, unanswerable, unadaptable, unexcitable, unrespectable
- in-: inconceivable, incurable, incorrigible, incredible, incorruptible, inescapable, inseparable, invariable
- **ir**-: irreparable, irresponsible, irreversible, irresistible, irreplaceable
- im-: immeasurable, immovable
- **dls** : disagreeable, <u>disrespectable</u>
- **non-** : non-perishable, non-durable, non-flammable

- → The data has **unresolvable** issues. (*Value in Health*)
- → It can usher in a whole climate of thinking, in which many **exciting and testable** theories are born ... (*The Selfish Gene*)



arguable vs. debatable

- argue = 근거를 제시하다 ("To **give reasons** for or against something" Britannica) = 논쟁하다 ("To disagree or fight by using angry words" Britannica)
- debate = 논쟁하다 ("To discuss with people whose opinions are different from your own" Britannica)
- arguable = 근거제시가 가능한 (can be argued **for**) → 근거 있는 (긍정적) = 논쟁 가능한 (can be argued **about**) → 불확실한, 의심스런 (부정적)
- debatable = 논쟁 가능한 (can be debated **about**) → 불확실한, 의심스런 (부정적)

arguable vs. debatable

- ▶ It is arguable whether AI could ever be given the status of moral personhood. (*Liberty Law*)
 → negative (debatable O)
- ➤ The vaccine is of debatable value—it has been known to make some people quite sick. (Britannia)
 → negative (arguable O)
- ▶ If you cannot show that you have an arguable case the Court may dismiss your application ... (Family Court of Australia) → positive (debatable X)
 - ▶ It is arguable that Islamophobia is primarily the fear of Muslim political agency. ... But what precisely is "feared" in Muslim political agency? (Centre for Ethnicity and Racism Studies)
 → positive (debatable X)
 - ➤ However, it is debatable that those services assist the adult learner population because most services are structured to assist traditional undergraduate students. (IGI Global)
 → negative (arguable X)
- arguable that: always positive

arguable vs. debatable

The Britannica Dictionary

arguable /ˈɑəgjuwəbəl/ 🌖 adjective

Britannica Dictionary definition of ARGUABLE

- 1: not certain or clearly true: open to argument, dispute, or question
 - That word's pronunciation is arguable.
 - the arguable [=questionable] benefits of trying to follow every fad diet
 - That is an arguable point of view.
- 2: possibly true used to say that there are good reasons for believing that a statement is true
 - It is arguable that he's the best writer of his generation.


debatable /dɪˈbeɪtəbəl/ • adjective

Britannica Dictionary definition of DEBATABLE

[more debatable; most debatable]

- used to say that something may or may not be true or real
 - The benefit of the tax cuts is highly debatable.
 - The vaccine is of debatable [=questionable] value—it has been known to make some people quite sick.
 - Whether the report is entirely accurate is debatable.

arguable vs. debatable



1b. V-able = can be easily V-ed (쉽게 V할 수있는)

- Asphalt is **combustible** but not **flammable**. Like a pile of lumber, it can catch fire, but only in rare circumstances. (*Asphalt Institute*)
- These "display typefaces" are good examples of fonts that are **legible**, but not **readable**. (*Data + Design*)
- Above all things he desires that his work may be clear and readable. (Early Theories of Translation)

- combustible (can be combusted): 태울 수 있는 → 연소가 가능한 (가연성)
- flammable (can be **easily** inflamed): 쉽게 태울 수 있는 -> 잘 타는 (인화성)
- legible (can be read (recognized)): 읽기 기능한
- readable (can be **easily** read): **쉽게** 읽을 수 있는, 가독성이 좋은 / 이해하기 쉬운, 재미있는
 - > ... find a compromise that is agreeable to both sides of the party. (Cambridge) -> can be agreed on
 - ➤ An agreeable character with essential traits of empathy, integrity, and warmth matters more than competence or innovation in relationship building. (*Public Relations Review*) → pleasant

1c. V-able = must be V-ed (V해야 하는, V해 마땅한)

- ➤ The fee is payable in monthly installments over the duration of your course. → can be paid
- ➤ The deposit is payable in advance and expected within 24 hours of booking to confirm.
 → must be paid
- > Even better, each undergraduate scholarship is renewable until graduation. -> can be renewed
- ➤ There is an annual subscription fee, which is renewable by the end of December each year.
 → must be renewed
- ➤ [Social Security report] "Other reportable events" In addition to the events listed on this form, you are responsible for reporting any other events that may affect benefit payments. → must be reported
- considerable: must be considered (고려해야 하는) > 상당한
- notable: must be noted (주목해야 하는) > 주목할 만한
- valuable: must be valued (가치를 부여해 마땅한) → 가치 있는
- detestable: must be detested (혐오해 마땅한) → 혐오스런
- deplorable (한탄할 만한, 통탄할), condemnable (비난할 만한)



1d. V-able = can V (V할 수있는: 능동형)

- V-able (능동) = can V = able to V
 - ➤ The catfish is adaptable to a wide range of water conditions. (Longman) → able to adapt
 - ➤ Hollow tile proved to be a robust and durable building material.
 Today, there are millions of square feet of floors and roofs built of hollow tile that are still serviceable. (Journal of Preservation Technology)
 → able to endure / able to service
- endure: 오래 가다 / 견디다 durable (오래 가는): The tile is durable. → can endure (능동) endurable (견딜 만한): The pain is endurable. → can be endured (수동)
- Perishable: able to perish → 상할 수 있는
- variable: able to vary → 가변적인
- changeable: able to change → 변화할 수 있는





1d. V-able = can V (V할 수있는: 능동)


- V-able (수동) = can be V-ed = can be **easily** V-ed = **must** be V-ed
 - V-able (능동) = can V = able to V V-ed = can **easily** V = **must** V = obliged to V
- ➤ The item is plastic, probably breakable, but not fragile like glass. (Amazon) → can break
- Do you have anything breakable in your bag? (Longman)
 can easily break
- ➤ The Commission remains **answerable** to the European Parliament for its policy choices in this domain ... (*Reforming the EU Treaties*) → **obliged to answer**
- changeable: can change easily > 변화무쌍한
- responsible: must respond (대응해야 하는) → 책임져야 하는
- accountable: must account → 해명해야 하는

- 1. 날씨가 변덕스러우므로, rain gear should be brought, and a warm pullover.
 - → As the weather is changeable (Field guide to the IGS post-symposium tour)
- 2. As far as a gene is concerned ... other genes are just a part of its environment, which can be compared to temperature, food, predators, or companions.
 - → comparable (*The Selfish Gene*)
- 3. ... it is a fallacy to suppose that genetically inherited traits are fixed and cannot be modified.
 - → unmodifiable (*The Selfish Gene*)
- 4. I refer to the **proposal I must object to** that the election of the medical officer should take place annually.
 - → objectionable proposal (*British Medical Journal*)

- 5. These failures may lead to abrupt or gradual battery degradation, and in some cases to damages that are impossible to repair and dangerous.
 - → irreparable and dangerous damages (*IEEE*)
- 6. [헤르페스 뇌염] On the 90th day after the onset, however, she became **easy to excite** and aggressive to her family.
 - → excitable (Brain and Development)
- 7. ... once they understood the process, they found that they could do it.
 - → found it doable (Artificial intelligence in education)
- 8. Our experiments show that this model can produce recognizable faces from **inputs that seem impossible to recognize**.
 - → seemingly unrecognizable inputs (*Stanford.edu*)

- 9. Examples of what amounted to an **offence for which a president can be impeached** included treason, corruption, and the abuse of a monopoly.
 - → impeachable offence (British Origins and American Practice of Impeachment)
- 10. The results did support that CT scan screening may provide a moment where smokers can be taught.
 - → teachable moment for smokers (Journal of the American Cancer Society)
